

## WHAT TO BRING TO VIC GATHERING 2009

- Personal belongings (clothes etc)
- **Sunscreen (SPF 30+) & Hat**
- Tent (Hike Tents are preferred)
- Extra Garbage Bags for Rubbish
- Uniform for travelling to and from VG and Closing Ceremony
- **Steel Tent Pegs** are a must as the ground at Gilwell is very hard.
- **BYO article to screen print with VG Graphics.**
- Food & Cooking equipment (lightweight) or buy food from our onsite canteen - menu enclosed. Please remember fire restrictions may apply. No open fires (fire restrictions).
- **Personal First Aid Kit.** This needs to include paracetamol and any anti-hystermines as prescribed for your own use. Ant and spiders bites prevalent.
- **Personal Information Record (PIR)** Form if it hasn't already been supplied or if there are any changes to the one you have provided, please fill in a new one and hand it in.  
*Leaders must also complete a PIR Form.*
- **Medical Forms** must be **up-to-date** with **ALL** medical issues clearly stated. All information provided is relevant to the care that your Venturer receives while at V.G.

### PLEASE NOTE

**NO ghetto blasters, whips, knives, laser pointers (which will not be returned!), sheath or large knives permitted.** If found they will be held in Administration for safe keeping until the end of VG (so don't bring them!), where they can be picked up after 1.30pm on the Sunday.

**NO alcohol and / or non prescribed drugs are to brought to VG.**

Any Venturer, 14-18 Guide, Rover, whole unit, single member or Leader found with alcohol or non prescribed drugs in their possession will be sent home immediately at their parent's, guardians' or own expense.

**All equipment must be carried onsite and offsite  
by foot or trek cart.**

**NO car/trailers will be permitted onsite,  
until after 2.30 pm on Sunday.**
